Do You Book Ahead?

Let's ask some dancers!



Barbara Briggs:
The only time I may book is when somebody asks me for a dance and I've already got a partner, then I will book the next one. But I have a tendency not to book ahead because I want to

include everybody and not shut anyone out. With booking ahead, it's hard to keep track and sometimes when you go to find your partner, somebody else has grabbed him, so I don't really like to book, but a lot of people book the whole dance.



Elliott Karpeles: I do it pretty much all

the time. When there are a lot of new people I will dance with them to help them, for the first couple of dances, but then after that I like to book ahead because

there are certain partners I like to dance with. I'll book through the first half or the second half of the evening. It's rare that I have a problem remembering who I booked with, but if I do I'm in trouble.



Kyre Adept: I notice if I book ahead too far, I come unstuck further down the line. However, booking one or two ahead I find quite acceptable. There are people I really want to dance

with and sometimes I know I'm not going to get to dance with them unless I book them when I see them.



Jonathand: I book ahead sometimes. I understand and appreciate the desire some dancers have to book ahead some of the time, so I sympathize with that.

At the same time, I appreciate it when most people don't book ahead most of the time. I think you will get different answers from men than from women. The gender that is having more trouble getting partners will book ahead more.
