MAUD KARPELES & CECL SHARP

By Gary Shapiro "...it has been proved beyond all doubt that the most suitable age to start dancing is the age you happen to be." -Maud Karpeles, 1931

Once or twice I've included the above quote in messages sent to our announcement lists. "Who is Maud Karpeles?" people asked.

Maud Karpeles encountered English folk song and dance in 1909, and was inspired to form a folk dance club. When Cecil Sharp gave lectures on folk dance, her club demonstrated the dances.

Later, Karpeles collaborated with Sharp, including trips to North America. Karpeles continued to collect and document country dances after Sharp's death.

And yes, it's true our very own Elliott Karpeles says he's a distant relative.
